Active Speech Lesson Plan

Target group: Young students (~ages 3-7) working on expressive language/vocabulary skills, Time: 30-45 minutes

Overview & Purpose: The Active Speech program is intended to be individualized and versatile. This lesson plan is one example of how Learnigo can be used with your students. The program can be used independently or as a supplement to other therapeutic and educational activities. This lesson plan is based on our Active Speech program, free to access with our 30-day trial.

Goal: Students will express concepts and formulate statements using target summer vocabulary during structured language activities.

Learning Objectives

- 1. Students will label target thematic vocabulary based on summer theme.
- 2. Students will formulate 2+ word statements using target vocabulary words.

1) Introduction: Go to Active Speech --> Thematic Activities--> Seasons: Summer

- Start with Activity 1/21.
- You can say: Here are four pictures showing the different seasons. Each season brings different weather and activities we can do.

Depending on the student(s) background experience, you may adjust how little/how much time you spend discussing each of the four pictures. You can ask what they see in the picture, if they've experienced this season, what kind of weather this season has, etc.

2) **Lesson:** Complete activities 2-20. If working as a group, take turns answering questions so that everyone in the group has a chance to demonstrate understanding.

3) Practice: Go to Active Speech --> Thematic Activities --> Thematic activities-Worksheets

- Print enough copies of the worksheet titled "Play bingo (1)" to play in pairs.
- Play a game of modified Bingo using the vocabulary words practiced in today's session.

4) **Review:** Go through each item on the bingo sheet and name them as a group.

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
