

Auditory Perception Lesson Plan



Age: 5-10 years old
Time: 25-35 minutes

Overview & Purpose: The Auditory Perception program is intended to be individualized and versatile. This lesson plan is one example of how Learnigo can be used with your students. The program can be used independently or as a supplement to other therapeutic and educational activities. This lesson plan is based on our Auditory Perception program, free to access with our trial.

Goal: Students aged 5-10 will identify auditory sequences and rhythms to improve their auditory perception abilities.

Learning Objectives

1. Students will identify sounds.
2. Students will sequence a series of sounds.

Activity

Warm-Up/Introduction: Using slide 6/25 Sequences and rhythms

You can say: *"You may not realize it, but your brain is working hard to listen, whether you're paying attention in class, playing your favorite game, or talking to a friend. Listening helps you learn new things and achieve your goals. Today we are going to do some activities that strengthen our listening muscles."*

Press Start. Students will listen to the audio.

Guided Questions: What did you hear? What animal did you hear first? Prompt students to place the visual of the sounds in the correct order.

Lesson: Using Slide 7/25. Sequences and rhythms.

1. Students will listen to audio recordings and pay attention to the order.
2. Working as a whole group, listen to the first audio and identify the sounds and their order. **Guided questions:** *What instrument did you hear? What was their order?*
3. Small group or pairs. Students will identify the sounds in the second audio and their order.

Practice: Use Slides 8/25 & 9/25 to continue to practice and identify sounds and their sequence.
